



# SEQ Sportfishing Challenge Hosted by the Brisbane SFC July 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> 2011

## Venue and Date:

Darling Point Sailing Club, Manly Harbour, July 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> 2011.

## Eligibility and Nominations:

Nominations will be taken up to June 24th. Cheques can be posted to PO Box 1022 Fortitude Valley 4006. All enquiries to Darryl Lund, 3396 7494 or 0417 750 097. Late nominations may be accepted at the discretion of the committee up to 8pm 1<sup>st</sup> July 2011.

## Nomination Fee:

Senior angler: \$40, includes PLI through ANSA. (ANSA members \$30). Juniors (less than 16 years old): \$10

## Facilities:

The Darling Point Sailing club has its own Boat Ramp and includes a large fenced area which will provide security for cars, boats and trailers parked on site. There are toilets and showers available and undercover areas for eating. Competitors are welcome to stay on site, but will need to provide their own bedding or swag.

Hot food will be available on the Friday night and Sunday lunch during the weigh-in. Soft drinks will be available for sale all weekend.

## Fishing Rules:

Fishing commences at midnight Friday and ceases at 11 am Sunday. All capture sheets need to be lodged by 11.30am Sunday. Late entries will not be accepted. The presentation of trophies and prizes will commence as soon as results are finalised.

All boats are to be launched and retrieved between Mooloolaba in the north, the Broadwater to the south. Fishing boundaries after launch are unrestricted. Land base fishing boundaries are the same as launch boundaries.

All fishing must comply with all current State regulations. Only fish on the current ANSA QLD eligible species list will be eligible for the competition. Only fish caught on Lure or fly are eligible. Anglers must hold the rod at all times while fishing.

All fish lengths will be measured on FORK length. All fish lengths are to be recorded on the provided score sheet, and in 2 digital photos, one photo with the fish on a brag mat and the other with the angler holding the fish. Both photos are to include the angler's registration card.



At least one angler from all teams must attend the briefing at 8pm on the Friday night. Anglers will be issued with their registration cards, score sheet and copy of rules and eligible species list at the briefing. We will also clarify the rules and make available the latest weather forecast. Safety responsibilities for all boating activities remain with the boats skipper.

Champion angler/team will be awarded on a point's basis of an angler's/team's, 5 best fish, one per species. Points are awarded on the basis of 1 point per cm, and a bonus of 150 points for each additional species.

A team consists of a minimum of 2 anglers fishing from the same boat. Land based anglers can form a team with a minimum of 2 anglers and a maximum of 3 anglers.

All photo's have to be uploaded to the club computers at the weigh in. Anglers will have to provide cameras with a download cord or SD cards for transfer of the photo's. The club reserves the right to use any photos for future club promotions.

Any protest must be made in writing to the disputes committee within 10 minutes of the completion of the weigh-in. Any decision then taken will be final.
